Please be advised that the District Office was notified of one staff member who tested positive for COVID-19 and another staff member who is probable. The individual who tested positive has not been on campus since before break. The probable individual was on campus on Monday, January 11, 2021. The district has already notified all close contacts.

The health and safety of our students and staff is our number one priority. We ask if you believe you have been in contact with anyone who may have symptoms of COVID-19 or you experience one or more symptoms from Group A or two or more symptoms from Group B below, to please stay home and contact your health care provider.
