Please be advised that on Sunday, November 15, 2020, the District Office was notified that a high school staff member tested positive for COVID-19. Erie County Technical students will report in person.

Monday, November 16th and Tuesday, November 17th will be asynchronous days where high school students will be required to log in and complete an assignment posted by their classroom teachers, no live-streaming will take place these two days. High school students will live-stream beginning on Wednesday, November 18th. Please contact the high school if you need to utilize the internet café.
